- Review of one or two other seminar papers
 - Review reports
- Improvement of your own seminar paper based on the reviews
 - The final version should address the valid points of the reviewers

- Masters Students
 - Max. 20 minutes presentation time
 - Approximately 5 minutes questions & answers and comments on presentation style
- Bachelor Students
 - Max. 15 minutes presentation time
 - Approximately 5 minutes questions & answers and comments on presentation style
